BACKGROUND:

Each month staff will prepare this report to update the Board on the status of previously identified highway issues. Items requiring Board action will be identified in a separate agenda item under Highway Matters.

DISCUSSION:

Pending Matters:

Supervisor Hardie

- Asked for speed reduction on Greenhouse Road.
- Requested widening of the right turn lane at the intersection of Calohan Road and Route 29, north bound lane.
- Requested stabilizing the gravel on the shoulders at the intersection of Wisecarver Road and Route 24.
- Requested improvements to the intersection of English Tavern Road and Route 29 to improve safety. Particularly, lengthening the turning lanes due to increased development in the area.

Supervisor Cline

- Requested VDOT to continue to monitor the intersection of Route 460 and Doss Road. There were recently two more accidents at this intersection. *VDOT is designing a mountable curb to provide greater separation between the travel lanes and the through lanes.*
- Requested a study to determine drainage improvements that can be done to Route 460 in the vicinity of Moore's Country Store to reduce flooding.

Supervisor Shockley

- Requested a speed study along Leesville Road from Leesville Estates to the City Limits due to increased development along the corridor. This request was supported by Supervisor Brown. *VDOT traffic engineering is working on a study.*

Supervisor Shockley for Supervisor Watts

- Requested review of signage locations at the intersection of Long Island Road and Route 501 to improve visibility.
