**ORDER**


This day came the parties upon the Motion For Summary Judgment and Motion To Dismiss filed herein by the defendant, Altavista Life Saving and First Aid Crew, Incorporated, ("Altavista EMS") and after reviewing the pleadings and admissions filed herein and the law memorandums submitted by counsel, and after hearing the argument of counsel, and for the reasons stated in the Court's October 11, 2007 letter opinion, the Court sustains the defendant's Motion For Summary Judgment and Motion To Dismiss on the issues of whether the County of Campbell, Virginia ("County"), can bill for the services of Altavista EMS and collect the proceeds thereof. The Court finds and Orders that: the parts of Article III, Chapter 10, of the Campbell County Code (the "Ordinance") which permit the County to bill for and collect the fees for services rendered by Altavista EMS, and which prohibit Altavista EMS from billing for and collecting its fees for services rendered, are void and unenforceable as to Altavista EMS; and that Altavista EMS has the right and is entitled to bill for and collect the fees for its services rendered and to collect its fees from insurance companies, Medicare and Medicaid.

It is further **ORDERED** that Article III of Chapter 10 of the Campbell County Code of 1988 is in all other respects enacted pursuant to due grant of authority from the General Assembly as found in VA. CODE ANN. §32.1-111.14 (Cum. Supp. 2007) and VA. CODE ANN. §27-14 (Repl. Vol. 2004).



And this case is continued on the docket for further order consistent with the above.


