# Agreement in Lieu of an Official Erosion and Sediment Control Plan Terms and Conditions

I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby understand that in lieu of submission of an Official Erosion and Sediment Control Plan, I agree to comply with **Campbell County's Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance**. These requirements shall be based on the conservation standards contained in the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation's Erosion and Sediment Control Handbook.

**As a minimum, I understand the following measures must be addressed:**

1. Silt fencing shall be properly installed downhill from any and all disturbed areas and around all soil stockpiles.
2. Construction entrances consisting of coarse aggregate stone shall be installed at the access point off any existing public or private right-of-way. **(Crush-n-Run is not acceptable)**
3. All denuded areas on the property shall be stabilized with permanent seeding within **seven (7) days** of final grading. If an area is not of final grade, but is to be left bare for more than thirty days, the area shall be temporarily seeded. All seeding will be covered with straw mulch.
4. Pipe inlet and outlet protection shall be provided around all culvert inlets and outlets.

If 10,000 square feet or greater is disturbed without the designation of a Responsible Land Disturber (RLD), a "Stop Work Order" will be issued immediately. No land-disturbing/construction activity on the property will be allowed until an RLD has been identified and associated fees have been paid. If the applicant refuses to comply, legal action may be pursued.

I understand that periodic site inspections can and will be made by Campbell County Erosion and Sediment Control Inspectors or authorized agents to ensure that all measures have been implemented and are adequately functioning. Failure to comply with such requirements within the specified time could result in enforcement actions for violation of the Campbell County Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance. Enforcement actions include, but are not limited to, a "Stop Work Order", revocation of permit, and legal action.

- All erosion controls are to be installed prior to any land disturbing activity.
- Campbell County shall notify the owner/contractor of any violations. Campbell County will also identify corrective action(s) and a date at which these violations are to be corrected.

I understand that if I disturb greater than one (1) acre, a Virginia Stormwater Management Program Permit must be obtained from the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR). Failure to obtain this permit could result in strict enforcement from DCR.
