

Haberer Building, 47 Courthouse Lane, Rustburg, Virginia, the Planning Commission for the County of Campbell, Virginia will consider whether to recommend the full adoption of an emergency ordinance amending Chapter 22-15(A)(17) of the Campbell County Code of 1988 pursuant to Va. Code Ann. §§ 15.2-1427 and 15.2-2204.

PLEASE FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held on Tuesday, January 6, 2026, at the hour of 7:00 P.M. in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room in the Walter J. Haberer Building, 47 Courthouse Lane, Rustburg, Virginia the Campbell County Board of Supervisors will consider the full adoption of an emergency ordinance amending Chapter 22-15(A)(17) of the Campbell County Code of 1988 pursuant to Va. Code Ann. §§ 15.2-1427 and 15.2-2204.

The descriptive summary of such change is the removal of "data centers" as a by-right use in Industrial-Heavy Zones and moving the same to Chapter 22-15(A)(28) as a special use only use in Industrial-Heavy Zones. The entire text of the above-noted proposed new ordinances and amendments of the Campbell County Code of 1988, as amended, is on file in the Office of the County Administrator, 2nd Floor, Walter J. Haberer Building, 47 Courthouse Lane, Rustburg, Virginia, and can be examined there between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The public is invited to attend and make its views known at the meeting of the Planning Commission of January 5, 2026 and at the meeting of the Board of Supervisors on January 6, 2026.
