# Danville Transfer Station

- In operation since 2021 under Virginia DEQ PBR 638
  - Replaced our Ringgold transfer station that was in operation since 2003 under Virginia DEQ PBR 196
- Roughly 45,000 tons/year of solid waste
- In-floor loading pit
- Waste hauled to Pittsylvania County's MSW landfill and Republic Services' MSW Upper Piedmont landfill






# Campbell County Transfer Station
